This will be a spectacle for sure, as the BC Pond is

Last Flight—Gary Best



On April 30, 2018 the Edmonton Pond lost one of its longest serving and still very active members, PMLG Gary Best.

Those attending the Blue Goose Christmas Luncheon this past December took the opportunity to celebrate Gary's 80th birthday as well as his 60 years in the Insurance Industry. And yes, he was still working!

In advance of the Christmas Luncheon, Gary's step-daughter Leslie McDougall (who herself followed Gary into a career as an adjuster), provided the following synopsis of Gary's work history:

Gary first delved into employment flipping burgers at George's Café when he was 16 yrs old. A lover of cars, he thought he could make it as a mechanic so he left high school early to work at Loveseth's Mechanics earning \$135 month. If you know Gary and his "handyman" qualities, he didn't last long getting his hands dirty, so he went to his Dad on his hands and knees begging him to let him go back and finish High School, which he did. After graduation, he started work as an Independent Insurance Adjuster with Henry C. Runte & Co. Adjusters earning him \$125 a month. Between 1963 and 1993 his career took him to work as a partner at Rikstad Graham and Best, Mandrusiak Best Adjusters and Best & Hagen Adjusters. In 1993 Gary tried retiring, but found he missed his working life. So he opened Gary Best & Co. Adjusters which he still operates. Since 2000 and to this day, Gary is a contract adjuster in the Risk Management and Insurance team with Alberta Finance (editor's note—Gary retired from Alberta Finance Jan 18, 2018). This year Gary not only celebrated 60 years as an Adjuster, but also his 80th Birthday!

Gary was initiated into the Edmonton Pond in 1961. Gary was a very active member of Blue Goose right up to the time of his passing. He served two years as Most Loyal Gander from 1989 to He was Co-chair (along with 1991. PMLGG Trev Newitt) of the 1993 Grand Nest Convention that was held in Edmonton. For many years he served as a Trustee of the Pond Development Fund, only stepping down from that role two years ago. Having attended a number of Grand Nest Conventions over the years, he was enthused about the 2018 Grand Nest Convention in Edmonton and became a financial supporter. Consistently, over the years, Gary was a regular attendee at Edmonton Pond meetings and events. Gary never disappeared into the background: he could always be counted on to support Edmonton Pond activities. To know Gary was to know that Blue Goose was important to him.

On hearing of Gary taking his last flight, MLGG/PMLG Mark Robertson commented "a sad day for the Edmonton Pond to lose such a strong supporter of our Order. Gary was not only my skip in BG Curling for many years, he was the gan-

der who introduced and initiated me into the Order back in 1994."

In passing along his condolences to Gary's wife Joan and the family, Grand Wielder of the Goose Quill Terry Maloney remarked that he "had the privilege to know him due to BG for so many years. Looking back, how lucky I was to see him at your GN mid-year in Edmonton." Terry was referring to the PMLG Dinner during the Grand Nest Officers Mid-year meeting in Edmonton in April, 2017 where Gary was honored for his 50+ years of membership.

Our thoughts are with Gary's wife Joan, children David, Donald and Robert; step-children Leslie, Cheryl and Janet and their respective families.

Gary was one of those individuals who completely embodied the ideals of Blue Goose. We shall miss him deeply.




