Greeting fellow Ganders from your Grand Nest representative. Most of you would not be aware but due to health issues I was not able to attend this year's 111th Annual Honorable Order of the Blue Goose Convention in Savannah, Georgia. I was able to skype into some meetings, and able to attend the installation ceremony of the Grand Nest Officers to be able to provide a live acceptance speech as the incoming Most Loyal Grand Gander for 2017 – 2018. It was a small consolation for missing out on the convention which I dearly wanted to attend.

At this year's convention, as the incoming Most Loyal Grand Gander it was my responsibility to locate a replacement for the Grand Keeper of the Golden Goose Egg Randal Wilson who was stepping down from this Grand Nest position. You may not be aware but the following positions are now appointed and not elected: Grand Wielder of the Goose Quill, Grand Keeper of the Golden Goose Egg, Grand Historian and the Judge Advocate. 2018 Convention



It's that time of year when kids head back to school and summer holidays are fading behind us. Our minds are shifting back into work mode and, for those on the 2018 Convention Planning Committee, we are

getting even closer to hosting the Grand Nest Convention in July 2018.

This summer was eventful for the committee. In July, several of us attended the 2017 Convention in Savannah, Georgia. This provided a fresh opportunity for us to see how another convention was organized and to col-lect ideas we could use to enhance our hosting of next year's convention. We also had a 30-minute time slot to make our formal presentation to the convention delegates and attendees. Our PowerPoint presentation showcased Edmonton and provided an overview of what could be expected in 2018. The presentation was complete with photographs of the city and local festivals. It also highlighted the Westin Hotel and the two locations, West Edmonton Mall and Fort Edmonton Park, that spouses and kids would be visiting. We touched upon the surrounding areas and tourist attractions that could be incorporated as part of a trip to Alberta. We distributed customized convention pins and 72-Hour Guides to the City of Edmonton. These components of the presentation created an engaging profile of the City of Edmonton and the activities to expect in and around the City next July. We received several positive comments afterwards saying that we did an excellent job convincing ganders to trek northward and visit Edmonton. So, we believe that we are off to a good start on promoting our convention.

This past spring, we introduced Gordie the Goose as our convention mascot. He traveled with us to Savannah and made quite a splash at the Convention. He attracted a lot of attention not only from convention delegates but also from Savannah locals. He's been busy about all his escapades on social media.


