LAST FLIGHT

On September 5th, 2016, our friend and colleague PMLG Ed Cannon took his last long flight at the age of 79.

Born in Saskatoon, SK, Ed married the love of his life, Audrey, on September 6, 1957. In addition to Audrey, his memory will be cherished by his son, Scott, 2 grandchildren and 3 great-grandchildren, all of whom were the joy of his life.

Ed's long career in the Insurance Industry began with Canadian General, with whom he transferred to Edmonton in 1960. A transfer to Calgary in 1967 was followed by a transfer back to Edmonton 3 years later. Following the sale of Canadian General, Ed embarked on the broker side of the business, working at various times with Reed Shaw (now AON), Seawright, and Sedgewick. In 1986 he became a partner in CMB Insurance Brokers. Ed's involvement in the Industry didn't end with retirement as he continued teaching courses and working for a period of time as an Information Officer for IBC.

Initiated into the Alberta Pond in 1969 during his time in Calgary, Ed took flight to the Edmonton Pond in 1971. After a hiatus in the mid'70's Ed rejoined Blue Goose in 1980 and became a very active member of the Edmonton Pond. He served as our MLG in 1997-98 and went on to serve as our Permanent Wielder of

the Goose Quill for a period starting in 2007. Only when spending winters in Yuma, AZ made it too difficult to carry out his duties did Ed relinquish that role.

Ed loved life and people. His many interests and activities included woodworking, hunting, fishing, curling and Old Timers Hockey. Whatever Ed did he approached with enthusiasm.

"60-40" was often Ed's hearty response when asked how he was. Throughout his life, "Mr. 60-40" exemplified the three principles of Blue Goose – Character, Charity, and Fellowship. He truly lived up to the Charge he received when initiated to be "firm in character, broad in charity and free in fellowship".

Hail friend, and farewell. We will miss you.

SAVANNAH REGISTRATION OPENS

It is with great Blue Goose pride and enthusiasm that the Southern Region announces we are ready to begin accepting reservations for the 2017 "Passport to the South" Grand Nest Convention.

Savannah, Georgia will be the host city. Savannah is listed as one of the top three vacation destinations in the USA! We hope you will come in early or extend your stay after the convention to take advantage and enjoy all Savannah has to offer.

The 2017 convention will be held at the Hyatt Regency Savannah Hotel, located right on the Savannah River. The formal convention dates are Tuesday, July 11th through Thursday, July 13. 2017. The Hyatt hotel rate is \$170, with complimentary Wi-Fi and reduced parking fee of \$19 per day. The hotel will extend the contracted rate 3 days before and after the Convention *subject to room availability*. Note: Savannah is a walking city, and a short distance from the local airport, so a car is not necessary.

The registration fee for the convention is \$375 for members, spouses, and young adults 16 years or older; \$300 for those under the age of 16. The Convention Registration fee covers all convention meals and scheduled activities – an estimated value of over \$700.

We want to <u>strongly encourage</u> every Pond to book at least one convention and hotel reservation for a Delegate to attend this convention. We ask that you to do this very early as we have a limited number of rooms set aside and the Southern Region would like to have every Pond and/or Puddle represented. Once the room block is filled, we cannot guarantee any additional rooms within the Hyatt Regency Savannah Hotel or at the contracted hotel rate.

Attached to this letter is a flyer about the convention. Go to <u>southernblue-</u> <u>goose.org</u> to see further details about the city of Savannah and the wonderful things the Southern Region has planned for you. You can also register for the convention and book your hotel room directly from the website.

Remember, this convention will *not* be a last minute registration convention due to the limited number of rooms in our reserved block. Savannah is a high vacation destination, so please book early to ensure your spot.


